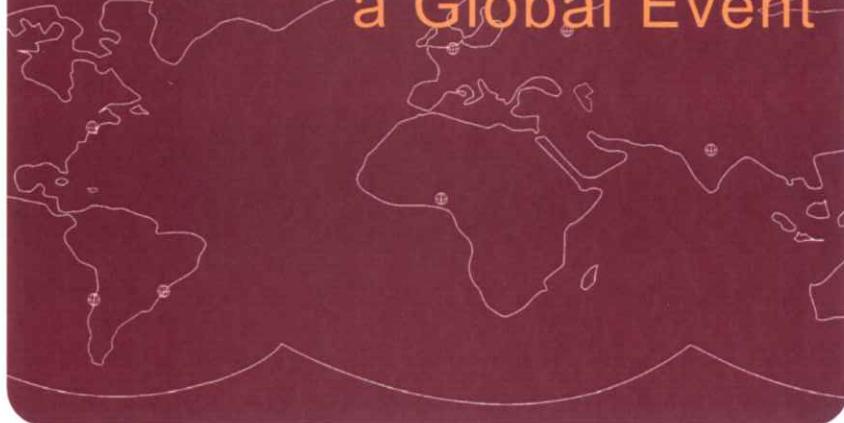

## Making a Local Experience into a Global Event



In at least 18 countries around the world, citizens will visit police stations in small groups to assess the station's public service by using the Altus Police Station Visitors Kit, a simple tool that citizens can use to assess how well police stations serve the public. The Kit contains a set of 20 easy questions divided into 5 assessment categories:

- Community Orientation
- Physical Conditions
- Equal Treatment of the Public
- Transparency and Accountability
- Detention Conditions
