YOUR Police Commission

The Los Angeles Police Commission will be addressing some very timely topics in upcoming episodes of "Your Police Commission." As most Angelenos know, there will soon be a new Chief of Police in Los Angeles. How does the City of Los Angeles choose a new Chief? Under the old Charter, a Chief stayed for an undetermined amount of time, however, under the new Charter, a Chief is limited to one five-year term with the possibility of being renewed for a second term. "Your Police Commission," will reveal the entire process for selecting a new Chief.

Again, taking topics from the headlines, "Your Police Commission," we'll take a hard look at LAPD's pursuit policy. Is it too restrictive? Is it too lenient? How do officers view it? What does the community think of the policy? What are the statistics? When and how does an officer initiate a police pursuit? How does LAPD compare to other law enforcement agencies in terms of policy? These questions and more will be answered on "Your Police Commission."

In 1979, the Los Angeles Police Department issued an internal mandate known as "Special Order 40." This document essentially states that an individual's undocumented alien status in itself is not a matter for police action. This order is currently being updated, yet the essence will remain. What does this policy mean to Angelenos? LAPD officials and those who question the effectiveness of the policy will discuss the details on "Your Police Commission."

"Concrete Canoe Races? Yes, Conrete!" –

Huell visits Newport Beach to survey the annual regional concrete canoe races hosted by the University of California, Irvine. Seventeen student civil engineering teams, attending universities from Hawaii to Arizona to Las Vegas and throughout Southern California, spent numerous hours designing and constructing concrete canoes to place in the competition. Huell speaks with some of the top teams about the building process, the rules of the competition and the excitement and sense of achievement felt by the students. Any misconceptions or stereotypes about engineers may be thrown away as this student project brings together friends, family and community to give a practical, simple, and enjoyable look at the field of engineering. – Friday, July 12, 9:00 p.m.

"Home Savings of America Mosaics" – Denis O'Conner is most famous for the large-scale mosaic murals he created for over one-hundred California branches of Home Savings of America. Although this bank is no longer in existence in California, his artwork still remains on the buildings, generally above the main entrance. Aside from his work with Home Savings, in 1963 O'Conner formed his own company, specializing in the execution and installation of over fifty mosaics. Join Huell as he travels to O'Conner's home in Ansa, California, to see exactly how much time and work it takes to put one of these extraordinarily beautiful mosaics together. – Friday, July 19, 9:00 p.m.

"Botanical Gardens and Organ Grinders" – On a day unlike any other, Huell takes a stroll through Descanso Gardens in La Canada, which is typically noted for its rosarium, camellia forest, and California native plant collections. However, what makes this day so special is that the Automatic Musical Instrument Collectors Association (AMICA) has cordially been invited to the gardens. AMICA is a non-profit organization devoted to the restoration, distribution and enjoyment of musical instruments that use perforated paper music rolls and perforated music books to create "the happiest music on earth." Monkey organs, French fairground organs, Dutch street organs, and calliopes are just a few of the instruments placed throughout the premises, which bring heightened enjoyment to the visitors. – Friday, July 26, 9:00 p.m.

For more than 12 years, LA CityView Channel 35 has provided gavel-to-gavel live coverage of City Council meetings. LA CityView Channel 35's award-winning coverage of the City Council now includes a much anticipated and needed Second Audio Program (SAP) feature. This feature will allow viewers with SAP capable television sets to watch Council meetings with live simultaneous Spanish translation.

"I am working to bring government closer to people in all Los Angeles neighborhoods, and that includes providing Spanish language translation so that Channel 35 is accessible to more people," said Mayor Hahn. "This is a great step toward making government more accessible to the public."

"Providing language translation for coverage of City Council meetings will enable more residents to be connected to their government," said Council President Padilla. "A truly cosmopolitan city like Los Angeles recognizes that we need to communicate effectively to all of our neighborhoods and to people of different backgrounds."

The City's Information Technology Agency's staff began the installation of SAP almost a year ago. The City Clerk's office was also instrumental in making SAP available by providing professional translators who possess the unique talent and skill of live simultaneous translation. Under the leadership of Councilman Mark Ridley-Thomas and Commission President Henry Gradstein and the other members of the Board of Information Technology Commission; SAP is now available in over 500,000 households.

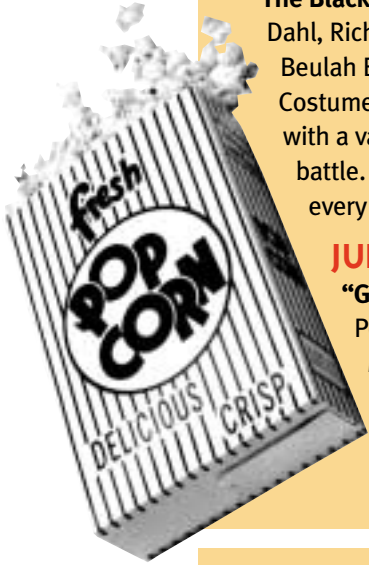
